# Investment Objectives

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund "Dynasty Prestinvest Flexible" Income is to achieve long term capital growth by investing in a balanced portfolio, composed of mainly fixed income securities. and in a lesser extent of equities.

#### Market Comment

The decline in inflation is marking time in major economies. As a result, the Western central bankers who met in Jackson Hole, as they do every year, are keeping a close eye on the end of the year.

This new fund was launched on May 12, 2023. The performance of the class F (EUR) share of the **Dynasty Prestinvest Flexible Income** fund remains flat since its inception.

The portfolio construction continues by following opportunities in both primary and secondary markets. As of 31st August, **88**% of the portfolio is invested.

The average YTM of the fund stands at **4.8%**. The average credit sensitivity is **2.4** and the average rating is **BBB+**. The fund is invested through **63** positions.






