## What is this product?

#### TYPE OF PRODUCT

The product is a sub-fund of Dynasty SICAV, an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

The Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However the Board of Directors of the Fund may decide to close the Fund under certain circumstances.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to achieve medium to long term capital growth by investing in a portfolio, composed of essentially fixed income securities and to a lesser extent equities.

The Sub-Fund is actively managed but uses the Bloomberg Global Aggregate & High Yield Corporate Custom Hedge USD Index (H38876US5 Index in Bloomberg) as a performance measure. The Sub-Fund is not bound by the components or weighting of the index when selecting investments and the Sub-Fund may invest in securities not included in the index. Due to the active nature of the management process, the portfolio of the Sub-Fund may deviate significantly from that of the index. The Sub-Fund does not offer any form of guarantee with respect to investment performance and no form of capital protection applies

The investment policy of the Sub-Fund consists in holding a portfolio of essentially of fixed income securities (80% minimum) and to a lesser extent in equities and ETFs (20% maximum).

The Sub-Fund will invest a minimum of 80% of its net assets in fixed income securities, such as:

- Standard bonds issued by Corporates or/and Governments;
- Convertible bonds or similar fixed income instruments (such as convertible preference shares, mandatory convertibles, bonds cum warrants, exchangeable bonds and other convertible bonds);
- Subordinated bonds (including perpetual bonds) limited to 30% of the Sub-Fund's net assets;
- Money Market Instruments.

The Sub-Fund will not invest in Contingent Convertible bonds ("Cocos").

The Sub-Fund's investments in fixed income securities will mainly be Investment Grade. At least a majority of the AUM of the portfolio will be allocated to investment grade fixed income instruments, as measured by the Management Company.

The Sub-Fund will not invest at the time of purchase in distressed securities

The Sub-Funds average interest rate sensitivity (duration) will range between 0 and 10 years.

Exposure to High Yield and/or unrated bonds will be possible up to 49% of the net assets of the Sub-Fund.

The Sub-Fund will invest up to 20% of its net assets in equity securities and ETFs such as:

- Listed equities;
- Warrants and listed options up to 10% of its net assets;

Investments will mainly be denominated in USD and based worldwide, including up to 30% in emerging markets.

The Sub-Fund may invest up to 10% of its net assets in UCITS and exchange traded funds (ETFs) compliant with the Directive 2009/65/EC. The investment objective of such UCITS and ETFs shall be compatible with that of the Sub-Fund. Under such circumstances, the Sub-Fund may only invest in UCITS and ETFs themselves investing in fixed income instruments and/or Money Market Instruments and/or Equities. Such UCITS and ETFs may be managed by the Management Company

Derivative instruments, such as fixed income futures, equity and index futures, listed options and OTC derivatives, may be used in the context of hedging the Sub-Funds assets against the interest rate risk, the equity risk and the foreign exchange risk. The commitment resulting from such transactions and contracts may not exceed the Sub-Funds assets.

The selection of the securities will essentially depend on maximizing the risk-reward profile. Furthermore, in case of adverse financial market conditions this Sub-Fund may temporarily be fully invested in Money Market Instruments in order to protect the Shareholders' interests.

The Sub-Fund will not hold more than 20% of its net assets in cash and deposits at sight (such as cash held in current accounts) for ancillary liquidity purposes in normal market conditions. Under exceptionally unfavourable market conditions and on a temporary basis, this limit may be increased up to 100% of its net assets, if justified in the interest of the investors

The Class CLASS AC USD shares is denominated in USD

This Class is cumulative. Dividend distributions are not planned.

#### INTENDED RETAIL INVESTORS

A typical investor in the Sub-Fund will be an experienced and long-term investor who knows and accepts the risks associated with this type of investment, as set in the Prospectus. The typical investor will be seeking to invest a portion of its overall portfolio in a balanced portfolio of fixed income and equities with the goal of obtaining capital appreciation. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 5 years.

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

## What happens if Dynasty AM S.A. is unable to pay out?

There is no guarantee in place against the default of the Fund and you could lose your capital if this happens.

The Fund's assets are held with UBS Europe SE, Luxembourg Branch and are segregated from the assets of other sub-funds of the Fund. The assets of the Fund cannot be used to pay the debts of other sub-funds.

## What are the costs?

### Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. ## Recommended Holding Period (RHP): 5 years.
